

Why the mayfly?

This aquatic insect lives dual lives—first, swimming around in our creeks and rivers for years at a time, and then emerging from the water to become a flying insect for less than 24 hours. Mayflies are critical to the aquatic food web, feeding the salmon that are born in our rivers and streams. But they can only live in areas with good water quality, which is something we as



humans impact every day. To us, mayflies are a symbol of healthy water, connectivity, rebirth, and the role we can all play in helping ecosystems thrive.

Why have a festival?

The 610-square mile Coos watershed (the area of land that drains from our surrounding foothills and rivers into the bay) is a very special place that is home to lots of fish, wildlife, plants, and people. Everything in our watershed is connected by water, which deserves celebrating! This is also a chance to showcase the people who keep our watershed healthy—and to teach our community about ways we can actively change our daily behavior in favor of watershed health.
